Düsseldorfer Künstler (VdDK) for
mutual support and assistance**

The Verein der Düsseldorfer Künstler (Association of Düsseldorf Artists) was established in 1844 to foster solidarity among its members and provide them with support and assistance. It is thus one of the oldest artists' associations in Germany that is still in existence. The VdDK celebrated its 180th anniversary in 2024 – which offered a fitting occasion to look back on its history and development and its current activities for supporting the city's artists.

In addition to providing its members with a strong network, the association actively champions new concepts for aesthetic education, social protection for artists, support for studios and the establishment of a building with workspaces for artists in Düsseldorf. A key element of its work is the SITTart exhibition space in Sittarder Strasse, where its members' latest works are displayed. The association also offers its members the opportunity to undertake a two-month residency at one of its three studios in the Cité Internationale des Arts in Paris.

As one of Germany's longest-standing artists' associations, the VdDK shares a significant history with other associations: while the oldest association in Germany – the Hamburger Künstlerverein (est. 1832) – no longer exists, other important artists' associations are still active today, such as the Verein Berliner Künstler (est. 1841), the Hannoverscher Künstlerverein (est. 1842) and the Künstlerverein Malkasten in Düsseldorf (est. 1848).

**Artists' associations and art
associations – an important distinction**

Unlike art associations, which focus on presenting contemporary art to a broad audience and fostering an appreciation of such art, artists' associations are alliances of artists themselves. They primarily serve to provide professional and social support and opportunities for networking and exchanges with colleagues.

Artists' associations pursue these objectives in various ways. For example, they support their members by providing workspaces, and also advise them on legal and financial issues. In addition, they organise meetings, discussions and workshops on a regular basis in order to promote an exchange of ideas among artists. They also stage events such as group exhibitions, open studios and art festivals to create a platform for presenting and marketing works of art. Moreover, they actively advocate for their members' interests by calling for better working conditions and greater social recognition for artists. Another key area of their work involves education and ongoing professional development: artists' associations offer courses, workshops and mentorship programmes and collaborate closely with universities and art schools to support the next generation of artists. Lastly, but no less important, they create a community based on solidarity and a strong network – a network that helps artists continue to develop their work and skills and strengthen their identity as producers of art.

**Kunsthalle Düsseldorf:
A venue for presenting artistic
perspectives in the city**

This exhibition in Kunsthalle Düsseldorf underscores the close link between the VdDK and the city's art landscape.


The first Kunsthalle, founded in 1881 on the initiative of the VdDK, was a central location for contemporary art and provided a framework for presenting the association's importance and the broad spectrum of its members.

The first Kunsthalle building was damaged in the Second World War and therefore had to be demolished later. As a striking, brutalist building, the Kunsthalle was reopened in 1967 at a new location in the neighbourhood, Grabbeplatz.

In the current exhibition, as in the entire Kunsthalle programme, historical developments are presented together with current trends and the challenges that artists are dealing with today.

The VdDK currently has 300 members, of whom 224 submitted a contribution to the exhibition. The roughly 250 works presented reveal the impressive diversity of artistic forms of expression – ranging from painting, drawing and sculpture to spatial installations, photography and video works. The three exhibition rooms in Kunsthalle Düsseldorf are being used to their full capacity and invite visitors to explore a remarkably diverse array of media.

The exhibition ... and we're just getting started not only provides an insight into the VdDK's history and activities; it also reveals the tremendous vitality of one of the oldest artists' associations in Germany – a forum for interaction, exchanges and mutual artistic further development.


